- 5. Read 1 Timothy 2:12. How could this verse be misinterpreted in today's culture? Why would that be a tendency?

- 7. Read Revelation 4:7-8. What pops into your mind when you read a passage like this? Why is this hard to understand? Can you think of any similar passages of Scripture?
