- 2. It is easy to pick leaders based on externals that have nothing to do with their character. What might be some of these externals?
- 3. The culture has always ignored the church. It is sad when Christians fail to understanding it's significance. How does 1 Timothy 3:15 challenge us to value the church?
- 4. Many today shy away from leadership. What might be some reasons why this happens? Read 1 Timothy 3:1. What does this verse communicate about leadership positions?
- 5. Pastor shared that these verses directly apply to those that we would call "Pastors" today but they apply to all Christians. Would you agree or disagree?
- 6. Read Acts 20:17-28 and 1 Peter 5:1-3. We see the three terms Elder, Overseer/Bishop and Pastor used to describe the same leadership position. What stands out from these passages about these leaders?
- 7. The list of qualifications begins with being "above reproach." Why is our testimony so important for a leader and for all Christians?
- 8. Leadership is not only about the things we "do" but also about the "don't." Why are the do nots in this list so important for leaders to model?
- 9. This was a long list, but it focuses on character. Was there one item that stood out to you. Share with your group your thoughts.
