Getting Started

5. Some believe that it is not necessary for believers to be baptized today. How does a passage like 1 Corinthians 1:13-16 challenge that way of thinking?
6. Read Luke 23:39-43. Many view baptism as a necessary part of salvation. How does this account of the thief on the cross challenge this view?
7. Read Titus 3:5-6. What is the emphasis of these verses? What is the important truth we learn about salvation?
8. Pastor spent time talking about the practice of infant baptism. In your mind, what is the biggest Biblical roadblock to this practice?
9. Pastor shared how baptism is also about identifying with other believers. Why is this necessary in a Christian's life?

2. _____ New Testament Christians Appear to Be Baptized

"Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Were you baptized into the name of Paul? I am thankful that I did not baptize any of you except Crispus and Gaius, so no one can say that you were baptized into my name. (Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I don't remember if I baptized anyone else.)"
