### Jesus Will Touch Others Through Me (If I will let Him!)

"The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!""

John 1:35–36 ESV

"The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus.

Jesus turned and saw them following and said to them, "What are you seeking?" And they said to him, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), "where are you staying?"" John 1:37–38 ESV

"He said to them, "Come and you will see." So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour." John 1:39 ESV

"One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother." John 1:40 ESV

"Philip found Nathanael and said to him, "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."" John 1:45 ESV
