10. Think of all that has been covered, what stands out to your about Christianity?



Seven Major World Views


1. **Theism**— an infinite God beyond and in the universe
2. **Atheism**— god does not exist beyond or in the universe
3. **Pantheism**— god is the universe
4. **Panentheism**— god is in the universe and beyond the universe
5. **Deism**— god is beyond the universe, not in it
6. **Finite Godism**— a finite god is beyond and in the universe
7. **Polytheism**— there are two or more finite gods in the universe
