

Why Do I Not Have Peace?
1. I am aPerson "They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is none who does good, not even one." Psalm 14:3 ESV
"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all." Isaiah 53:6 ESV
2. I Instinctively Attempt to God
"For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him." John 3:17 ESV

Definition: Justification — the process by which sinful human beings are made acceptable to a holy God.

(Millard Erickson, Concise Dictionary of Christian Theology)

I Have Peace When I am Right With God.

Four Insights on Being at Peace with God 1. Jesus is God's Solution for My Sin!

"But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who helieve." *Romans 3:21–22a ESV*

"Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom he is pleased!"" Luke 2:14 ESV (Also 1 Peter 1:12)

2. Jesus is the Only Way to a Relationship with God!

"For there is no distinction: for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," Romans 3:22b-23 ESV

3. Jesus' Gift to You it Justification!

"and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that Romans 3:24 ESV is in Christ Jesus,"

Definition: Redemption is Christ's delivering us from the punishment by paying the penalty of sin. (Millard Erickson, Concise Dictionary of Christian Theology)

4. Jesus' Sinless Life was the Payment for your Freedom!

"whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith." Romans 3:25a ESV

Definition: Propitiation is a reference to Christ's death satisfying the wrath of God. (Millard Erickson, Concise Dictionary of Christian Theology)
