1. What I Do (with my mind and hands) - "the house that he had built"

"So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God."

1 Corinthians 10:31 ESV

- 2. What I Eat and Drink "the food of his table"
- **3. How I Organize (my life) -** "the seating of his officials"
- **4. How I Treat Others -** "the attendance of his servants, ... his cupbearers"
- 5. How I Dress (attention to detail) "their clothing"
- **6. How I Worship -** "and his burnt offerings that he offered at the house of the LORD"
