# I. Be Selective with My Partnerships

"For three years Syria and Israel continued without war. But in the third year Jehoshaphat the king of Judah came down to the king of Israel."

"And the king of Israel said to his servants, "Do you know that Ramoth-gilead belongs to us, and we keep quiet and do not take it out of the hand of the king of Syria?" And he said to Jehoshaphat, "Will you go with me to battle at Ramoth-gilead?" And Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel, "I am as you are, my people as your people, my horses as your horses.""

And they said, "Go up, for the Lord will give it into the hand of the king.""

## IV. Be Prepared to Receive the Truth

But the king said to him, "How many times shall I make you swear that you speak to me nothing but the truth in the name of the LORD?""

#### V. Be Careful Who You Listen To

"And Micaiah said, "Therefore hear the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on his throne, and all the host of heaven standing beside him on his right hand and on his left; and the LORD said, 'Who will entice Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramoth-gilead?' And one said one thing, and another said another. Then a spirit came forward and stood before the LORD, saying, 'I will entice him.' And the LORD said to him, 'By what means?' And he said, 'I will go out, and will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets.' And he said, 'You are to entice him, and you shall succeed; go out and do so.'"
