Four Keys for Working Together—Moving Forward

I. Embrace the Diversity of Our Church

"For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit."

Three Features of God's Design for Our Church

- 1. One Body, Many Members
- 2. A Work of the Holy Spirit

"In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit," Ephesians 1:13 ESV

- 3. Diversity by God's Design
 - Jews and Gentiles
 - Slave and Free
 - Male and Female
