"If she does not please her master, who has designated her for himself, then he shall let her be redeemed. He shall have no right to sell her to a foreign people, since he has broken faith with Exodus 21:8 ESV her."

## of Israel from Egypt

"but it is because the LORD loves you and is keeping the oath that he swore to your fathers, that the LORD has brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, Deuteronomy 7:8 ESV from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.'

Why Jesus Blood?

- The Old and New Covenants Required a Blood Payment (Hebrews 9:18)

- Jesus Blood was a Single Permanent Payment (Hebrews 9:25; 10:4,12)

- Jesus Established the New Covenant of Grace (Hebrews 9:12-14)

#### - Riches of His \_\_\_\_

"In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, which he lavished upon us, in all wisdom and insight" Ephesians 1:7–8 ESV

Grace: —goodwill freely disseminated (by God); especially to the benefit of the recipient regardless of the benefit accrued to the disseminator.

"Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?" Romans 2:4 ESV

"To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." Colossians 1:27 ESV
